

It's a terrific way to help spark a child's creativity and imagination, and to inspire young healers for years to come.

NOW IT'S TIME TO PUT IT TOGETHER!

Don't worry, assembling your new activity center is simple, and we're here to help. It may go a little faster with a partner to lend a hand, but we've made it so one person can assemble the center. Here are a few tips before you begin:

- Read through all the instructions first.
- · Clear a flat, covered space (carpeted is best) to lay out all the materials so everything is close at hand.
- You will need a Phillips head screwdriver to assemble the center.
- The instructions include lots of helpful pictures—we show you, step-by-step, exactly how to align pieces and parts for speedy and accurate assembly. Note that hardware needed for each step is shown in the upper right corner of the page, each piece being added in a given step is highlighted in gray, and the "assembled view" (what it looks like in the finished center when the step is completed) is included in the lower right corner of every page.
- In the instructions, the name of a part is followed by a letter or number in parenthesis. This letter or number corresponds to the sticker on the part, as well as the picture of the part shown on pages 2-3.
- · Helpful hints are highlighted with a large exclamation point.


- Do not allow children to pull, climb, or stand on any part of the activity center.


Ensure the activity center continues to function properly and safely by regularly checking the hardware and tightening when necessary.

WOODEN PANELS - Be Smart—Sort Your Parts




OTHER PARTS



Helpful Hints and Tips

- Note: Some packages of hardware may have extra pieces
- You will need a Phillips head screwdriver to assemble the activity center.



IMPORTANT

Be smart—sort your parts!
Be sure you have all required parts BEFORE beginning assembly!







DO NOT use power tools to assemble. Using power tools will cause product to crack!







To complete assembly, use hand-held screwdriver to fully tighten all screws until they're snug.




STEP 1 - Every Journey Begins with the First Step

Using 4 long screw screws (part 24), attach the office side panel (part A) to main support panel (part B).









STEP 2 - Get Your Kicks.

Using 1 long screw (part 24), attach the examination kick plate (part C) to the main support panel (part B).








STEP 3 - Here to Support You

- First, using 1 long screw (part 24), attach the bottom surface bar (part D) to the center support shelf (part E).
- Second, slide the bottom shelf panel (part F) into the groove in the center support shelf.









STEP 4 - Get Into the Groove

Slide the shelf assembly into the lower grooves in the main support panel. Using 2 long screws (part 24), attach the shelf assembly.






STEP 5 - Don't Forget the Dowels

- First, slide 4 wooden dowels (part 25) into the seat support (part G).
- Second, using 1 long screw (part 24), attach the seat support to the center shelf support (part E).







STEP 6 - We're on Your Side

Using 3 long screws (part 24), attach the side panel (part H) to the assembly (parts C, F, & G).









STEP 7 - Divide and Conquer

Slide the lower divider panels (part I) between the grooves in the main support panel (part B), center shelf support (part E), and the side panel (part H).








STEP 8 - Bring on the Bench

Using 3 long screws (part 24), attach the bench (part J) to the assembly.











STEP 9 - Fascia Your Fears

- First, slide the bench fascia (part K) into place beneath the bench (part J). Push up into the grooves.
- Second, using 4 long screws (part 24), attach the bench fascia to the assembly.












STEP 10 - Brace Yourself

Using 1 long screw (part 24), attach exam bed back brace (part L) to the main support panel (part B).








STEP 11 - Groovy

Slide the upper divider panel (part M) down into the grooves on the main support panel (part B) and the side panel (part H).





STEP 12 - Have a Seat

- First, rotate or move to the opposite side of the assembly.
- Second, slide the seat (part N) into the assembly.
- Third, using 2 long screws (part 24), attach the seat to the assembly.






STEP 13 - By Golly, It's the Gusset


- First, insert a dowel (part 25) into the hole in the bench gusset (part O).
- Second, insert bench gusset into the dowel hole in the side panel (part H). Using 1 long screw (part 24), attach the bench gusset to the bench (part J).





STEP 14 - Turn, Turn, Turn

Rotate or move to the side of the assembly.



STEP 15 - Do It Your-Shelf

- First, insert the notches on the office shelf (part P) into the grooves on main support panel (part B).
- Second, using 1 long screw (part 24), attach the office shelf to the office side panel (part A).



STEP 16 - Move to the Grooves

Slide the sink divider (part Q) into the groove in the office shelf (part P) and the groove in the main support panel (part B).






STEP 17 - Wow-els, That's a Lot of Dowels

- First, slide 6 wooden dowels (part 25) into the holes on the sides and the top of the office shelf fascias (part R).
- Second, using 2 long screws (part 24), attach the office shelf fascias to the office side panel (part A). Barrel nuts should not be visible after attached, and the hole on bottom of shelf fascias should be near office side panel.








STEP 18 - This is the End (Panel)

- First, using 3 long screws (part 24), attach the office end panel (part S) to the office fascias (part R) and the office shelf (part P).
- Second, using 4 long screws (part 24), attach the office end panel to the main support panel (part B).










STEP 19 - Look, a Hook

Connect the open sign hook (part 1A), slot grommet (part 2), and folder rack (part 3) to the office end panel (part S).









STEP 20 - Counter Attack

• First, lower the counter top (part T) onto the assembly. Make sure the wooden dowel on the top of the fascia is inserted into the dowel hole on the underside of the counter top. Using 4 long screws (part 24), attach the counter top to the assembly.




• Second, using 1 long screw (part 24), attach the counter top to the main support panel (part B).



STEP 21 - Talk and Pay


- First, insert the cell phone cradle (part 4) into the main support panel (part B).
- Second, insert the credit card machine (part 7) into the slots in the counter top (part T).






STEP 22 - Don't Leave Out the Spout

• First, insert the faucet (part 5) into the counter top (part T). From beneath the counter top, attach the faucet screw (part 6) to secure the faucet.




• Second, insert the credit card (part 11) into the credit card machine (part 7).






STEP 23 - Add the Door and More

- First, insert phone (part 10) into phone cradle.
- · Second, attach the door (part 12) by inserting the hinge pins into holes inside the office shelf fascia (part R) and office shelf (part P). Insert top pin first. The lower hinge pin flexes to help it attach to the shelf.









STEP 24 - Get Back

- First, rotate or move to the side of the assembly.
- Second, lower the bench back (part U) into the groove in the bench (part J).
- Third, using 2 long screws (part 24) and 1 small screw (part 26), attach the bench back to the assembly. The small screw goes into the phone cradle.







STEP 25 - Picture This

• First, attach the picture frame (part 14) to the notches in the upper divider (part M). Frame itself faces the waiting room side. Push the bottom of frame into the notches on upper divider.




• Second, attach the x-ray clip (part 15) and the accessory hook (part 1B) to the notches in the upper divider (the hook sits in the remaining space next to the picture frame).

STEP 26 - The Pressure Is On


- First, insert the bpm card (part 16) into the bpm base (part 17).
- Second, attach the bpm assembly to the main support panel (part B). Insert the bpm knob (part 18) through the holes in the bpm base and the main support panel. From the other side of the main support panel, connect the bpm knob with the bpm knob back (part 19).



STEP 27 - A Tall Order

- First, choose to display either inches or centimeters and slide the height rod (part 20) into the height rod channel (part 21).
- Second, clip the height rod assembly to the groove on the office end panel (part H).
- Third, insert the sink (part 8) and the lotion pump (part 9) into the counter top. Line up tab in lotion pump with notch in hole.






STEP 28 - Sign Up Now

- First, fit the sign (part V) into the groove in the sign base (part W). Using 2 long screws (part 24), attach the sign to the sign base.
- Second, using 5 long screws (part 24), attach the sign assembly to the side panel (part H) and the main support panel (part B).

YOU DID IT!

Now the real fun begins—it's time to stay and get healthy and to examine and treat pretend injuries and illnesses of all kinds! Here are some of the special features of the Get Well Doctor Activity Center:

- MULTI-SIDED FOR ALL AROUND FUN: From check-in to checkup to check-out, the center has it all! There's a
 waiting room where patients can fill out their forms and wait their turn; a reception and prep area for
 collecting information and payment, washing up, and storing medical supplies; an area for weighing and
 measuring patients, and an exam room for full checkups!
- EXAMINATION ESSENTIALS: Young doctors have all the latest equipment for examining patients! There's a sliding height bar that measures in both inches and centimeters, a realistic tipping scale with sliding weight, and an eye exam chart. Use the blood pressure monitor with cuff and a dial that turns and clicks. Hang the two included x-rays on the x-ray clip to read them. A fun "Your Body" chart details the parts of the body so patients can point out where it hurts!
- CLEANLINESS MATTERS: Avoid germs and contamination by washing up in the sink with swiveling faucet and
 a handle that turns. Push the pump for pretend soap or sanitizing lotion.
- CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT: A handy folder rack holds a reusable patient information file that can be filled out and returned in the file return slot. A hook holds a double-sided sign with office hours on one side and directions for check-in on the other. When it's time to check out, use the credit card in the card machine to pay the bill!
- HAVE A SEAT: The waiting room features lots to keep patients occupied, including a colorful chart with health tips and an aquarium picture. There's a frame with a window view—slide in a reversible card to either "close the blinds" or display the doctor's diploma!
- ON TIME: Move the hands on the clock to set the time, and spin the roller to show the wait time!
- LOTS OF STORAGE & PLAY SPACE: A shelf under the examination bench, and the counter, shelves, and
 "refrigerator" on the reception/prep side offer ample room for storing all a young doctor's supplies! There are
 movable hooks for doctor tools (tools not included) and even a handy cradle for storing the wooden cell
 phone.
- SAFETY FIRST: High-quality materials ensure strength and durability, while smooth, curved corners and edges offer peace of mind.
